2024-2025 PROPOSED LEGISLATION AND LOCAL FUNDING REQUESTS

LEGISLATION (NOT ALL LEGISLATION LISTED)

This year I sponsored 20 legislative bills. Although we know several will not make it through the process - these bills were symbolically filed to bring attention to the needs for all Floridians.

SB 1408: PREVENTION OF DISTRACTED DRIVING

This bill will expand the laws around distracted driving in Florida: right now, the ban is typing on a cell phone with some exceptions. As a state, we have incredibly high crashes and fatalities with inconsistent data around distracted driving. Our streets deserve to be safer for passengers, pedestrians and drivers.



SB 670: COVERAGE FOR MAMMOGRAMS AND SUPPLEMENTAL BREAST CANCER SCREENINGS

This bill would close a gap in Medicaid coverage: right now, only at-risk women are eligible for breast cancer screenings. This disease could strike anyone at any time, and is fatal if it's noticed too late. It also expands preventative screening and coverage for Medicaid patients, expanding access to healthcare for all women.
