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The purpose and goal is to repair the support structure below the bridge deck and to retrofit the handrails on the bridge deck to bring them up to current standards.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Competitively solicit the services of a bridge retrofit contractor and execute contract for them to provide the construction of the necessary structural retrofit of the existing bridge.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The extension of the useful lifespan of this bridge which serves as a main transportation route for citizens and students who live, commute and attend schools in this area to the east of the bridge.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this project is the citizens and visitors of the City of West Palm Beach with an estimated population of 120,000 together with any visitors to the City traversing this bridge.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit of this project is that it will extend the lifespan of the current bridge.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Unless the Contract is otherwise modified as approved by the Agency, the Agency may withhold future payments until all deliverables have been satisfied or the contract has otherwise been modified. Should City fail to meet deliverables after being given an opportunity to cure, Agency may require reversion of funds to the State.
