	The 1921 African-American church is a two-story brick building with two towers on the front and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places as an excellent example of an eclectic Gothic style structure. The site was the home of the St. Luke Church from 1888 until 1985. Unfortunately the building was heavily damaged by Hurricane Michael in 2018, the nave of the building was destroyed beyond restoration, however the narthex consisting of two towers and front facade were damaged but remain standing and can be restored. This project is to demolish and remove the debris of the nave area and be converted to an open courtyard preserving the original footprint of the church building, along with other restorable vertical portions of the historic building. The former nave will be a courtyard and will be designed to provide flexible seating and open-air event space. The majestic two towers, the narthex, and the facade of the church will be restored to the original condition.

Preservation of the history of this African American community in the Main Street/CRA District as well as the entire community is essential for the future. The site will serve the school district, as it did at the time of initial construction, community groups for the historical significance as to how the community has evolved around this church that is a significant structure to the state, region, and local community. When preserved it will serve as a destination for all to learn and appreciate its contribution to the community's history. A significant piece of minority history will be gone if the church is not preserved.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The restored St. Luke Church will serve as an educational site for not only Jackson County, but also the region as a place to learn and experience the history of the African-American minority community. In addition, the site will serve other community groups, not only from Jackson County but also from the region as an icon for historical significance as to how the community and region evolved around the church and area.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services provided as a result of this project will be providing educational, recreational, and historic resource to the city and Community Redevelopment Area. In addition, the facility will provide an outdoor venue for events, both public and private, along with parking.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The entire population of Marianna, Florida, directly, which is approximately 6,245. However, the facility would serve not only Jackson County but also fellow Floridians that want to experience education, culture and community life of a small rural Florida community. It should also be noted that Jackson County, along with all cities within the county have been designated by the Governor as a Rural Area of Opportunity, (RAO) formally Rural Area of Critical Economic Concern (RACEC).

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome is to have an educational and historic site that preserves the history and community life reflective in small rural communities, with a focus on African-American culture, throughout the region. This will be a one of a kind event and education facility for the region.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The contracting agency, City of Marianna has established a Critical Path with date specific targets for pre-development. Once bids are received and awarded for the project, the contract will have specific contract completion dates, if not met contractor will be subject to Liquidated Damages, assessed on a daily basis.
