a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Improved vehicular and pedestrian access throughout the city and the historic Main Street area. Rehabilitation of crumbling sidewalks and eroded streets. Improvements to the Main Street area for compatibility with city's goals of economic revitalization and development. The commercial areas of the downtown Main Street area also lack traffic calming devices. This funding would promote slowing down of traffic to encourage shopping.

Planning and engineering. Public engagement as to the compatibility of street and sidewalk improvements that would add value to the visibility of storefronts and enhance the pedestrian experience.

Sidewalk and street improvements & enhancements for a more vibrant, pedestrian friendly commercial core. Lighting and improved handicap parking including striping for parking. Residential streets would benefit with road resurfacing and sidewalk improvements to schools. Cracked sidewalk repair would improve safety near the historic areas of Main Street. Pot holes would be remedied.

All residents of the city would benefit from the improvements. Residential areas would benefit from the safety measures regarding road re-surfacing and improved sidewalk connectivity and commercial areas would benefit from economic development and revitalization.
