4. Project/Program Description

KIPP Jacksonville Public Schools has grown from one campus with 90 students in 2010 to now over 2,400 students across four campuses K-12. We launched our high school in 2021 and now are in need of renovations and additions to our existing high school campus to accommodate our growth. The high school is housed in a building originally occupied by elementary students. The first phase of this project will be the construction of a high school gymnasium, football field, bleachers, and auditorium renovation. KIPP's black student population is 95%. Our learning disadvantaged student population is 12% and 100% of our students are on free breakfast, lunch, and snack. These additions to our school will be life changing for our students, opening up access and opportunities we previously could not provide.

The current building our high school is in was donated by the city in 2010. Now that the high school is housed here, we need to add the proper facilities. The sports facilities will support our sports programs and community engagement opportunities. The auditorium renovation will ensure we have the proper facility to support our music, drama, and art programs. This request is in line with our strategic plan, as our high school will be at full capacity by 2025.

We plan on opening up our gymnasium and football field/track for community use. Here on the west side, there are no community turf fields for activities like flag football, youth football leagues, etc.

The target population would be our current students. 2,400 students would be served. Of course the greater youth population on the north and west side of Jacksonville, over 40,000 students, would potentially be served through youth sports programs.

- 3, The high school can host concerts, plays, and recitals.
