The initiative aims to empower these entrepreneurs through seminars, business consulting, advanced services, and access to capital.

Specifically, Hispanic Federation will provide bilingual online and inperson capacity building training and services at no cost to non-profit and for-profit community businesses to launch, maintain, and expand their businesses. Workshops will include one-on-one mentoring in small business management, financial literacy, basic accounting, digital skills, business management, legal considerations, licensing, minority certification, feasibility and business planning, taxes, access to capital including loan produts, grants, and financing.
